# Enhancing the Old Age Security Program

Seniors are an important part of our communities. I am committed to making sure that our Government provides the support needed for healthy ageing.

Minister Jean-Yves Duclos recently announced Old Age Security (OAS) benefits would be enhanced effective July 1, 2018.

This means that a single senior receiving OAS and the Guaranteed Income Supplement and having no other income may receive \$1728.84 more than they did in November 2015.

These changes will have a positive impact on nearly 900,000 vulnerable seniors across Canada, of which, 70% are women. Our goal is to continue to make investments that will help close the gaps in our system and ensure that every senior gets the support they deserve and no one is left behind.

# MacWilliam Road Culvert Replacement in Salisbury

The MacWilliam Road is a crucial link for the Hilltop neighbourhood and has been cutoff in the past due to flooding.

In 2016 the Federal government contributed more than \$1 million to a \$2.1 million project to replace aging and undersized culverts and adjusting the road grades and related road work on the MacWilliam Road in Salisbury to prevent flooding.

The project also included replacing Albert Trail Culvert #1 and the Larsen Lane culvert which were aged and undersized for the volume of water flowing through them.

Work is completed and now the Village of Salisbury can be confident as they plan for sustainable growth and make investments to further strengthen the community.
